1. This is an application u/s 439 Cr.P.C seeking interim bail for the period of 45 days, moved on behalf of applicant/accused Sandeep Yadav @ Kake.

2. Reply to the present application has been filed by the IO.

3. The present bail application has been moved by the Ld. Counsel for applicant/ accused on the ground that the mother of applicant/ accused is suffering from serious medical ailments i.e., multi organ failure and was admitted in the hospital from 05.10.2025 to 16.12.2025 and the doctors have said that she has only few days of her life and advised to take care her at home and she is on oxygen support, therefore, the presence of applicant/ accused is required with his mother in her last moments of life. It is further submitted by Ld. Counsel for applicant/ accused that the applicant/ accused has been languishing in JC since 29.04.2023 and the investigation has completed and no further custodial interrogation qua the present applicant/ accused is required as all the public witnesses have been examined and only police officials are pending to be examined in the present matter. Hence, the present bail application.

4. Ld. Addl. PP strongly opposed the present bail application stating that the deceased was brutally murdered by cutting the neck completely from the body by the accused persons. The material witnesses are under examination and there is possibility that these witnesses may be threatened by the applicant/accused if bail is granted to him.

5. Heard. Perused.

6. Considering the submissions of the prosecution as well as the fact that the material witnesses are under examination and there is elder brother to take care of the mother of applicant/accused, the present interim bail application of applicant/accused is dismissed.

7. Accordingly, the present bail application is disposed of.
