Heard.

It is stated that identity of the accused will not be disputed and the applicant has no objection if any witness is examined in his absence.

In view of contents of application and submissions made before me, the application is considered and allowed for today only.

Matter is fixed today for DE.

At the very outset, it is submitted on behalf of accused no. 1 Rajeev Chandok by the counsel that he wants to

close DE. In view of submissions made, **DE on behalf of accused no. 1 stands closed.**

Sh. Sunil Kumar witness from L&DO office and Sh. Dilip Kumar, witness from Commercial Office, Meter Reading Branch, Commercial Office, Meter Reading Branch, NDMC are examined, cross-examined and discharged as DW-2 & DW-3 respectively, on behalf of accused no. 2 Harvinder Singh. Diet money paid to both these witnesses.

One witness namely Ajay Mathur from House Tax department is also present but it is submitted by Id. Counsel for accused no. 2 that he does not want to examine the said witness and wants to drop him. In view of submissions made, said witness is also discharged.

It is stated by Id. Counsel for accused no. 2 that no other witness is to be examined on his behalf and DE may be closed. Separate statement of Id. Counsel for accused no. 2 is recorded in this regard.

In view of submissions made and statement recorded today, **DE stands closed on behalf of accused no. 2.**

It has already come on record on behalf of accused no. 3 Ashu Jhingan that he does not want to lead defense evidence. In such circumstances, **DE of all the accused persons stands concluded.**

Matter is now adjourned for final arguments for
15.11.2025.
