Fresh suit for declaration, partition and permanent injunction received by way of assignment. Be checked and registered.

Present : Sh. Sudeep Singh, Ld. Counsel for plaintiffs.

1. Ld. Counsel for plaintiffs has submitted that the present suit is with respect to the estate of deceased Sh. Bishan Swaroop Goyal and the plaintiffs are the son and daughters of the pre-deceased daughter of the deceased. It is further submitted that at the time of death of Sh. Bishan Swaroop Goyal, there were nine Class-I legal heirs of the deceased. Plaintiffs have 1/15th share each in the estate of the deceased.
2. Vide this suit, the plaintiffs wish to seek partition as well as declaration of the Relinquishment Deed dated 22.02.2025 as illegal, null and void.
3. In view of submissions made, issue summons of the suit and notice of the application under Order XXXIX Rule 1 & 2 CPC to defendants on filing of PF during the course of the day through all permissible modes for NDOH.
