This E Filling Petition is coming on this day for hearing before me in the presence of Thiru.M.Senthil Madurai, Advocate for the petitioner and of Selvi.P.Sumathi, Special Public Prosecutor for the State, and upon perusing both sides contentions, this court delivered the following:

ORDER

The petitioner /Accused has filed this Petition filed U/s.483 of BNSS, praying to enlarge him on bail for the alleged offence punishable u/s. Sec.9(f), 10, 21(1) of POCSO Act 2012, r/w. 75 of JJ Act 2015 in Cr.No.38/2026 of AWPS Kallakurichi petitioner/Accused was remanded on 06.08.2026

The learned Counsel for the petitioner/Accused would state that the petitioner/Accused is an innocent person and not in anyway connected with the above alleged offences, and a false case has been foisted against him and that he is having a permanent abode and was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 06.08.2026 and is in custody for the past 5 days and is ready to abide by any conditions to be imposed by this court and prays to release him on bail.

The Learned Spl.Public Prosecutor has filed the written objection stating that the Petitioner is the science teacher of the Government School at Malaikottalam Village. That the 10 victim girls are studying in the said school the petitioner has committed aggravated sexual assault and that the investigation is pending, if he is released he would tamper and threatened the victim and the other witnesses. Hence, prays for dismissal of the petition.

Heard Both sides. Records perused. The case was registered against the petitioner for the offences punishable U/s.9(f), 10, 21(1) of POCSO Act 2012, r/w. 75 of JJ Act 2015. From the FIR it is seen that the victims are aged 15 years, the petitioner is aged about 50 years. The petitioner is working as a science teacher in the Government School at Malaikottalam Village. That the 10 victim girls were studying in the said school. It is alleged that the petitioner committed aggravated sexual assault against the victim girls on the school premises. The investigation is pending. Medical Examination of the victims are not completed. The statements of victims u/s.183 of BNSS have also not been recorded. Considering the argument of Special Public Prosecutor that if the petitioner is released on bail, there is every possibility of his absconding and tampering with the evidence is acceptable one. Considering the gravity and nature of the allegations, the age of the victims, the position held by the petitioner as a teacher, and the stage of investigation, this court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.. **Hence this bail petition is dismissed.**
