STATE Vs. TRILOK CHAND AND ORS

There is one time bound case listed before the court today for evidence. In addition to that five bail applications are listed for orders and around 24 misc. applications including 12 applications for bail are listed before the court. In the circumstances, it is not possible to grant any passover.

One of the stenographers is on leave today and no substitute steno has been provided.

Matter is listed for DE, however, for the reasons mentioned hereinabove and further for the reason that the regular Addl. PP for State is on leave, evidence can not be recorded today.

Reply to the application of the accused Trilok Chand filed for seeking extension of interim bail granted vide order dated 24.03.2026 has been filed by the IO. Copy supplied.

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Arguments heard on the application.

It is not disputed that the applicant Trilok Chand's medical condition has not improved and he is currently admitted in the ICU at the District Hospital Neemach. The record of treatment has been verified by the IO. In the circumstances, the interim bail granted to the applicant Trilok Chand is further extended for a period of 60 days on the same conditions as imposed by the Ld. Predecessor vide order dated 03.12.2024. The surety Sh. Rakesh is present before the court and he submits that the surety bond already furnished may be extended for a further period of 60 days of extension of the interim bail.

In view of the submissions, the surety bonds already furnished are accepted for the said period of 60 days. The application IA no. 16/26 stands disposed off. Copy of this order be given dasti.

At this stage, accused Trilok Chand has filed an application u/s 94 BNSS seeking preservation of certain record pertaining to Toll Plaza of the vehicle's used in the raid. Copy supplied to the State. Matter be listed for arguments on the said application on **16.07.2026**.
