1. Application under Section 151 CPC has been filed by plaintiff seeking directions to the Branch Manager, Karur Vysya bank, Karnal branch, Haryana to deposit an amount of Rs.10 lacs from the account bearing no.4203152000000096 (NRI account) of defendant. Copy of application supplied to Ld. Counsel for defendant on his email ID.
2. Ld. Counsel for plaintiff has submitted that vide order dated 17.05.2024, defendant was directed to deposit amount of Rs.10 lacs out of sale proceeds of the suit property. He has further submitted that the said direction has not yet been complied and to protect his interest, he has filed the present application.
3. Ld. Counsel for defendant has submitted that he will seek instructions as to the balance amount in the said account. He further submits that he will file reply to the application on or before NDOH. He further submits that he has no objection if the direction to hold the amount of Rs.10 lacs, if the amount is available in the account of defendant, is passed.
4. Submissions heard. Application perused.
5. In view of submissions made, let reply to the application be filed atleast one week prior to NDOH with advance copy to plaintiff.

6. Report as to the balance amount in the said account be called from the Branch Manager, Karur Vysya bank, Karnal branch, Haryana for NDOH. The Bank Manager is also directed that amount of Rs.10 lacs be kept on hold in the said account in case the account is having balance of Rs.10 lacs. In case, there is lessor amount in the said account, the said amount shall be kept on hold and shall not be allowed to be withdrawn till NDOH.
