

PROCEEDING BEFORE LOK ADALATH

Case is called before Lok Adalath.

The counsel for Petitioner and Respondent insurance company have filed the joint memo reporting about settlement.

In the joint memo, it is stated that, parties have settled the matter for Rs.5,00,000/- and the Insurance Company has agreed to deposit the said amount, through due process of law.

On being questioned with the petitioner with respect to the contents of joint memo, party has agreed with respect to the terms and conditions forthcoming in the joint memo.

Along with the joint memo, Perused the copy of Aadhar card of the petitioner. Identity of the petitioner is confirmed. Hence, I am of the view that Joint memo is in accordance with law and both the parties have accepted the contents of the same, the parties have voluntarily appeared before the court and compromised the matter. Same is to be accepted. Hence, in the interest of justice, I proceed to pass the following:

ORDER

Joint memo filed by both the parties is hereby allowed.

Consequently, petition filed by the petitioner is hereby allowed subject to the terms and conditions of compromise forthcoming in the joint memo. As per the

settlement both the parties have settled their dispute for Rs.5,00,000/-. The Respondent insurance company is hereby directed to deposit the amount of Rs.5,00,000/- before this court within TWO month from the date of this order.

After deposit of amount, entire amount shall be release in the name of petitioner's account through RTGS/ NEFT by way of E-payment.

Draw award accordingly .
