Appellant Raj Kishore was convicted for offence U/s. 457 IPC & Section 380 IPC by Ld. JMFC-02, South-East District, vide judgment dated 25/01/2025. Vide order on sentence dated 12/02/2025, the appellant was sentenced to undergo Simple Imprisonment of 01 year for offence U/s. 457 IPC alongwith fine of Rs.1,000/-, in default of which he shall undergo Simple Imprisonment of one 01 month. He was sentenced to undergo Simple Imprisonment of 01 year for offence U/s. 380 IPC alongwith fine of Rs.1,000/-, in default of which he shall undergo Simple Imprisonment of one 01 month.

The appeal is accompanied by application U/s. 430 of BNSS, 2023, seeking suspension of sentence and grant of bail.

Heard. The application is considered and allowed.

The order of sentence dated 12/02/2025 shall remain suspended till further orders during pendency of present appeal. The appellant/convict is admitted to bail subject to furnishing personal bond in the sum of Rs.20,000/- with one surety of like amount, to the satisfaction of Ld. Trial Court, within 07 working days.
