RAJNI Vs. STATE NCT OF DELHI

Present : Petitioner in person with Id. Counsel, Sh. Sanjeev Kumar Sharma.

It is submitted by Id. Counsel for petitioner that the original Will in question dated 12.12.1989 is not traceable, however, during the course of proceedings, certified copy of the Will would be placed on record from the Sub Registrar office as the Will in question was duly registered. It is further submitted that Section 281 of Indian Succession Act could not be complied with as both the attesting witnesses have also passed away and that relevant evidence would be brought on record to prove handwriting of the attesting witnesses.

Keeping in view submissions made, let notice of the petition be issued to respondents on filing of PF and RC. Publication of the notice be also carried out in newspapers “The Statesman” of English edition and “Veer Arjun” Hindi edition, on filing of PF and publication charges returnable **for 09.02.2023**.

Citation of publication be also affixed at a conspicuous place outside the court.
