**ORDER BELOW EXH.1**

1] By this application, the applicant has sought grant of regular bail under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023 is filed by the applicant/accused Revannath Gorakh Chole seeking anticipatory bail in the event of his arrest in connection with **Crime No.162/2026** registered with Police Station, Wadwani, Tal. Wadwani, Dist. Beed against himself for the offences punishable under Sections 123, 223, 274 and 275 of B.N.S., 2023.

2] Informant Adinath Babasaheb Tandale lodged complaint alleging that, on **01/08/2026**, at **16:00 hours**, **Revannath Gorakh Chole**, R/o Khadki, Taluka Vadwani, District Beed, is illegally selling banned gutkha stock, which is hazardous to human health and banned by the Government of Maharashtra in retail to people near the Pimpaltekda Phata on the Chikhalbeed road is selling in retail. When they reached the square at Pimpaltekda Phata at around 17:00 hours, a blue-colored **Maruti Suzuki Swift car** bearing registration number **MH-12-DY-0148** was seen parked there. One person standing outside the car was seen handing over small pouches of gutkha

to people. Seeing our vehicle, he immediately sat in the car and attempted to speed away. Seeing him flee, the people buying gutkha also dispersed. When we pursued the car for about 500 to 600 meters, near Chikhalbeed village on the road, the car stopped and the driver alighted and fled. We pursued him on foot and caught him and seized Guthkha total worth of Rs. **2,65,820/-**.

3] The applicant sought anticipatory bail on the grounds that, the complaint filed against him is false and baseless. He has no connection with the incident and his name has been falsely implicated in this crime. The muddemal and offender Car bearing registration No. MH-12-DY-0148 have been already seized by the Police and further police custody of this applicant/ accused is not necessary. The applicant is farmer and earns his livelihood through farming. His family members dependent on him and he is only breadwinner of his family. The applicant is not having any past criminal antecedents. He is not a habitual offender and undertakes to co-operate with the investigation and abide by any conditions imposed by this Court.

4] I have heard Ld. Advocate Shri. S. R. He vehemently submitted that there are false allegations against the applicant. Almost investigation is completed and muddemal has been already seized by the Police. Hence, prayed to grant anticipatory bail.

I have heard Ld. APP Shri Waghmare. It is submitted that the offence is serious. The necessary order may be pass.

5] Heard both sides. Perused application and say filed by APP for State. On the backdrop of complaint allegations are on **01/08/2026**, at **16:00 hours**, **Revannath Gorakh Chole**, R/o Khadki, Taluka Vadwani, District Beed, is illegally selling banned gutkha stock in **Maruti Suzuki Swift car** bearing registration number **MH-12-DY-0148**. Police caught him and seized Guthkha total worth of Rs. **2,65,820/-**. The muddemal has been already seized and most of the investigation is completed. It is settled principal of law that, "Bail is Rule and Jail is exception". He has no any criminal antecedent. No purpose will be suffice by keeping applicant behind bar. He has not criminal antecedents. Hence, order :-

### **ORDER**

1. Criminal Bail Application No. 271/2026 is allowed.
2. In the event of arrest, applicant/accused **Revannath Gorakh Chole** be released on bail on his executing personal bond of **Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand Only)** with one surety in like amount in connection with **Cr. No. 162/2026** registered at Police Station, Wadwani, Tal. Wadwani, Dist. Beed for offence punishable under Sections 123, 223, 274 and 275 of B.N.S., 2023, 2023.
- 3 Applicant/accused to remain present before the Investigating Officer of respondent Police Station on every Saturday in between 11.00 a.m. to 2.00 p.m. for next one month, in failure the bail will be cancelled.
- 4 Applicant/accused not to threaten and pressurize

the complainant and the witnesses and tamper with the prosecution evidence, in failure of any condition bail will be cancelled.

- 5 Inform to the concerned Police Station.
- 6 In above terms, present Criminal Bail application stands disposed off accordingly.
