**ORDER PASSED BELOW BAIL APPLICATION
(Passed on 24th November, 2025)**

This is an application for bail moved by the accused under section 480 of the B.N.S.S. in connection with C. R. No. 154/2025 registered in the Churchgate Railway police station for the offence punishable under section 303 (2) of the BNS.

2. Read the application. Accordingly, the say of Ld. A. P. P. and I.O. was called. They filed their say and objected the application on the ground that the investigation is yet not completed. If the accused released on bail he would abscond. The accused would also pressurize the prosecution witnesses. The accused would commit similar type of offence again.

3. Heard the Ld. Advocate Shri B. N. Tiwari for the accused. Admittedly, the offence is non bailable, but not punishable with death or imprisonment for life. It is alleged that the accused has committed theft of the informant's mobile handset, which has been recovered. So also, there is no material on the record to show that accused is an habitual offender.

4. Having regard to the nature of offence and stage of the

investigation, if the bail is granted subject to certain conditions no harm or prejudice would be caused to the prosecution. Hence, in result thereof, I pass the following order :-

ORDER

1. The Bail Application No. 517 of 2025 is allowed and disposed of.
2. Accused namely Jayprakash s/o Subhashchandra Yadav is released on bail on his executing P R. Bond of Rs.15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand only) with one local solvent surety of the like amount.
3. Accused shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence and shall not hamper in the investigation and shall not make any inducement to the person acquainted with the facts of the case, so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to police or to the Court.
4. Accused shall attend the concern police station as and when required.
5. Accused shall co-operate the Investigating Officer.
6. Accused shall submit authenticated copy of his identity and address proof.
7. Accused shall not indulge himself in the same kind of offence here-in-after.
8. Provisional cash bail of Rs. 15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand Only) is granted for Four weeks.
9. Office to inform to the accused immediately. Issue letter to the Jail Authority accordingly.
