STATE Vs. SULTAN AZIM

File taken up today on an application under Section 483 of Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, filed on behalf of the applicant/accused Sultan Azim for grant of interim bail.

1. I heard the submissions on the present application made on behalf of the applicant/accused Sultan Azim for grant of interim bail for a period of 10 days.

2. Ld. Counsel for the applicant/accused submitted that the real brother of the applicant/accused namely Shandar Mansoor had expired on 28.02.2026 and on the same day, this court granted custody parole to the applicant/accused to attend the funeral of his real brother. Ld. Counsel further submitted that the applicant/accused also wants to attend family ritual (Biswa) of his brother which is to be performed on 22.03.2026 and that the presence of the applicant/accused is required for the emotional support and to shoulder family responsibilities in this critical period. Ld. Counsel thus, prayed that the applicant/accused ought to be granted interim bail on

humanitarian ground and he is ready to abide by all the terms and conditions imposed upon him by this court.

3. *Per contra* Ld. Addl. PP for the State opposed the interim bail application as per law.

4. As per the report of IO, the death of his brother has already been verified. Perusal of the record reveals that earlier also, the applicant/accused had been granted interim bail on certain occasions and that he surrendered after completion of the interim bail period.

5. In view of the aforementioned submissions, taking a lenient and humanitarian view, I deem it fit to grant interim bail to accused Sultan Azim for a period of three days from the date of his release to attend the 'Biswa ceremony' to be performed on 22nd March, 2026, on his furnishing personal bond with surety bond of Rs. 25,000/- with one surety in the like amount, subject to following conditions:

i) The applicant/accused shall not try to contact the prosecution witnesses in any manner;

ii) He shall not tamper with evidence in any manner.

iii) He shall also furnish his mobile phone and mobile phone of his surety to the IO and shall keep his mobile phone operational round the clock and shall share his Google PIN to IO.

6. In compliance of **Sanjay Singh Vs. State (Govt of N.C.T of Delhi) Writ Petition Criminal 974/2022**, copy of this order be sent to concerned Jail Superintendent to convey the order to inmate.

7. **Accused Sultan Azim shall surrender before concerned Jail Superintendent on the expiry of his interim bail period.**
8. Order be given dasti.
