4. Whether the plaintiffs are entitled to directions of handing over of original documents of late Sh. Bhagwant Singh Meena. OPP
5. Whether the plaintiffs are entitled to decree of mandatory injunction? OPP
6. Whether the deceased left the Will dated 27.12.2022 allegedly executed by the deceased as her last and valid Will? OPD
7. Whether the suit is properly valued for the purpose of court fee? OPP
8. Relief.

No other issue arises or pressed for.
