Memo of appearance filed on behalf of accused Sumit @
Bala. Same is taken on record.

Exemption application has been moved on behalf of accused
Sumit @ Bala on the ground that he is residing with his Buaji and he
has gone to hospital for treatment of his Buaji due to which he cannot
appear before the Court.

No medical documents in support of the above submissions
has been filed along with other application. The Court is not satisfy
with the reasons for the exemption mentioned in the application. Even
the counsel for accused is not present today.

Witness Ct. Manish is present. It appears that accused Sumit
@ Bala is deliberately not appearing in the court to delay the trial. In

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the opinion of the court, presence of accused cannot be secured without taking coercive action against him. Therefore, **issue NBWs against accused Sumit @ Bala and notice to his surety for next date of hearing.**

As one of the accused Sumit @ Bala is absent, therefore, witness Ct. Manish is discharged unexamined.

IO submits that witness 'X' is suffering pneumonia and therefore, 'X' is unable to appear before the Court today.

IO further submits that witness 'X' is a minor boy and therefore, he has to be examined in Vulnerable Witness Deposition Room. **Intimation be sent to Vulnerable witness room for next date of hearing.**

Issue fresh summons to witnesses Manish, 'X', IO and MHC(M) with case property for next date.
