File taken up today on an application filed on behalf of the applicant/accused Ashish @ Kalu for cancellation of NBW issued against him.

1. The regular Ld. Addl. PP for the State, attached with this court, is on leave today.

2. I heard submissions on the present application for cancellation of NBW issued against the applicant/accused Ashish @ Kalu.

3. Ld. Counsel for the applicant/accused submitted that applicant/accused could not appear before this court on the last date of hearing i.e. 06.03.2026 as he had gone to his hometown in connection with his marriage solemnized on 18-19.02.2026 and there were the post marriage rituals which happened on the occasion of holi. Ld. Counsel further submitted that his absence was neither intentional nor deliberate and thus, prayed that NBW issued against him ought to be cancelled.

4 Heard. Record perused.

5. Considering the submissions and in view of the reasons mentioned in the application regarding his absence on the

last date of hearing, the application as filed is allowed and accordingly, NBW issued against the applicant/accused Ashish @ Kalu and notice to his surety are hereby cancelled, subject to cost of Rs 1,000/- to be paid before DLSA, South-East. Cost deposited.

6. The applicant/accused is warned to be careful in future and is directed to appear on each and every date of hearing in time.

7. Application stands disposed of accordingly.

8. Order be given dasti.
