Fresh untrace DAR report filed. It be checked and registered.

Present: Sh. Deepak Kumar Maurya, Ld. Counsel for victim (minor) alongwith father of minor injured in person.
IO ASI Surender Kumar in person.

Father of injured has appeared and stated that he is satisfied with the investigation carried out by the IO and he has no objection if the report filed by the IO is accepted as untraced.

Statement of father of injured to this effect is recorded separately.

As there is no disclosure regarding number of offending vehicle nor any probability of it being located and complainant/ injured also could not note down the particulars of the vehicle, therefore, untraced report is accepted with liberty to the Investigating Officer to initiate investigation as and when any detail about the offending vehicle is traced out.

In view of the statement made, the case is disposed off as untraced.

At this stage, it may be noted that Sec. 396(4) of BNSS:

Where the offender is not traced or identified, but the victim is identified, and where no trial takes place, the victim or his dependents may make an application to the State or the District Legal Services Authority for award of compensation.

As such copy of this order be given dasti to the claimant to enable her to approach DLSA for relief, if permissible.
