1) The learned counsel for the appellant submits that today, the appellant has brought ₹3000/- in cash to be paid to the respondent, who refuses to accept the same. The learned counsel for respondent submits that the appellant had to pay EMI of ₹10,000/- against the total amount of ₹50,000/- and till date, she has only paid single EMI of ₹10,000/- and the EMI for the month of January remains unpaid.

2) Heard.

3) In view of the above submissions and contention lodged by the respondent, last and final opportunity is granted to the appellant to make good her commitment of paying ₹10,000/- EMI on or before the next date of hearing i.e., **11.02.2026**. It is clarified that in case the appellant fails to make payment of ₹10,000/- on 11.02.2026, law shall have its own course and the Court will proceed with arguments on the appeal.
