Matter is listed today for consideration.

At this stage, ld. Associate counsel for counsel for plaintiff has filed an application under Order XI Rule 1 (5) r/w Section 151 CPC for placing additional documents on record.

Heard on above application.

Ld. counsel for plaintiff submits that on last date of hearing i.e. 10.02.2026, the plaintiff has filed list of documents alongwith documents, however, said list of documents was filed after filing of the present suit and the list of documents was also not accompanied by application for placing the documents on record. He further submits that due to inadvertent mistake, only one RO (release order) was filed alongwith the plaint and two ROs could not be filed. He further submits that all the three ROs pertains to same date i.e. 25.10.2024. He further submits that the Invoices were also sent by plaintiff to the defendant through e-mail, however the said e mails were not traceable at the time of filing of the suit and hence the said e mails also could not be filed alongwith the plaint. He also submits that the present application is for taking on record above said two ROs dated 25.10.2024 and three e-mails dated 08.11.2024.

In the instant matter, as yet summons have not been issued to the defendants and matter is at a very initial stage. Therefore, considering the above facts and circumstances and submissions of Id. Counsel for plaintiff, the instant application for placing on record the above mentioned documents deserves to be allowed and accordingly same is allowed.

The above application bearing I.A. No. 1/2026 is accordingly disposed of.

The present suit has been filed by Plaintiff against the defendants for recovery of Rs.6,68,986/- alongwith interest @18% p.a. The suit is accompanied by statement of truth, non-starter report and court fees.

Issue summons for settlement of issues and notice of the application, if any, to the defendants through e-mail, Whats App as well as by ordinary process, speed post and approved courier, returnable on 18.03.2026, subject to filing of PF/RC, deposit of necessary charges within 10 days directing the defendant to file written statement / reply within statutory period.
