Ld. APP is present for the prosecution. Accused persons namely Sri. Abhijit Sutradhar and Smt.Champa Ghosh are present along with their Ld. Engaged counsel Mr. A Datta by filing hazira. Ld. Counsel Sri A Datta has filed a petition for allowing the accused persons to remain on bail under section 437A of CrPC on the strength of bail bonds submitted previously on the ground stated therein which stands allowed upon consideration. Heard argument from both the sides. Let the matter be placed before me after recess for passing judgment. Later on, Now this case record is taken up for passing judgment. Judgment is ready and prepared in the separate sheets of paper and the same has been pronounced in the open court. The operative portion of judgment runs as follows: “Hence, it is O R D E R E D 9. That the accused persons namely Sri. Abhijit Sutradhar and Smt. Champa Ghosh are		

		hereby found “not guilty” and accordingly are acquitted from the charge of this case under section 498A/494 of IPC and section 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961, and section 494 of IPC respectively, in view of section 248(1) of the Code of Criminal Procedure and set at liberty forthwith. 10. The surety of the accused persons during trial stands discharged from the liability of respective bail bonds. 11. The case is disposed of on contest with an order of acquittal. 12. Let a copy of this judgment be supplied to both the accused persons free of cost. 13. Enter the result in CIS as well as in the Germane Register. 14. The record shall be consigned to the record room after complying all legal formalities. 15. The Judgment is given under my hand and seal of this Ld.
