I have given thoughtful consideration to the submissions of  
Ld. Counsel. However, at the stage of charge, it is to be seen whether the  
material on record when corralled together is sufficient enough to raise the  
strong suspicion of the commission of the offence by the accused.

I have perused the statement of complainant and material  
documents. There is sufficient material on record to frame charge against  
all three accused persons for the offence punishable u/s. 307/34 IPC and  
charge for the offence u/s. 25 Arms Act against accused Abjal Ali. Separate  
charges framed accordingly to which all three accused persons pleaded not  
guilty and claimed trial.

Issue summons to complainant / injured Deepak, IO and  
MHC(M) with case property for next date of hearing.
