This is an application for the release of the applicant/accused Aman on personal bond.

Present: Sh. S. K. Kain, Ld. Addl. PP for the State.
None for the applicant/accused.

1. I perused the application made on behalf of the applicant/accused Aman for his release on personal bond.
2. In the application, it is stated that the applicant/accused was granted bail by this court on 14.08.2025, subject to furnishing of personal bond with surety bond of Rs. 25,000/- with one surety of the like amount and certain other conditions. It is further stated in the application that the applicant/accused is a very poor person and his family is facing several financial hardships to furnish surety and thus, it is prayed that the applicant/accused may be released on personal bond as despite being granted regular bail, he is still languishing in judicial custody.
3. Record perused.
4. A perusal of record reveals that the accused was granted bail by this court way back on 14.08.2025. However, despite being granted bail, he has been languishing in JC as he is unable to furnish his surety bond of Rs. 25,000 till date.

5. In the abovesaid circumstances, taking into account the submissions made in the application and further taking a lenient and humanitarian view, the present applicant/accused Aman is directed to be released on his furnishing personal bond of Rs 25,000/-. Other conditions will remain the same.
6. The application as filed is hereby disposed of.
