**** First Anticipatory Bail application under Section 482 of BNSS. ****

ORDER:

This order will dispose of bail application under Section 482 BNSS filed by applicant/accused Gurpal Singh @ Gurpal Singh Khepar, Hira Lal and Narinder Kumar, in case FIR No.117 dated 28.07.2026, under Sections **115 (2), 118 (1), 351 (3), 3 (5) of BNS.** of BNS, P.S. City Balachaur.

2. Notice of the bail application was given to State. Ld. APP for the State appeared and record has been produced` by I.O.

3. The accused/applicants have filed the present bail application on the ground that they are innocent and have not committed any offence and have been falsely implicated. They never caused injuries to the complainant party as alleged rather the complainant party of the present case caused injuries to them. No custodial interrogation is required. Lastly, a prayer has been made to admit the applicant/accused on bail.

4. On the other hand, learned Additional Public Prosecutor, appearing on behalf of State has opposed the bail application by submitting that accused/applicants have committed the heinous offence. Prayer has been made to dismiss the bail application.

5. I have heard Ld. APP for the State as well as Ld. Counsel for the accused/applicant and have perused the record carefully.

6. Since, Ld. Counsel for complainant has appeared and has submitted before the Court that there is every likelihood of compromise

between the parties and request has been made to refer the matter before Mediation Center. Since, it is desirable that before deciding this anticipatory bail application, the parties be referred for mediation. Moreover, learned counsel appearing on behalf of applicants/accused and complainant as well as learned Additional Public Prosecutor representing State have also shown their inclination in referring the matter to Mediation Center. As such, in view of these facts and circumstances and request as made by learned counsel for applicant/accused, present bail application is referred to Mediation Center. However, in order to facilitate the applicant/accused to attend the Mediation, this Court also deem it fit to grant umbrella of interim anticipatory bail to the applicant but only for the purpose for mediation but otherwise, applicant/accused shall not claim any right for taking benefit of anticipatory bail which shall be decided exclusively on merits, if mediation fails. Both the parties are directed to appear before Mediation Center on 14.08.2026 for mediation. Copy of this order be sent to Nodal Officer, Mediation and Conciliation Center, SBS Nagar for compliance. Let the report of Mediation Center be awaited for 20.08.2026.
