Applicant/accused Sahil Bidhuri has sought interim bail on the ground that his grandmother has expired yesterday i.e. 03/06/2026 and he needs to attend and perform her last rites. The factum of death has been verified by SHO PS Kalkaji. Copy of receipt dated 03/06/2026 of emergency department regarding rushing Smt. Murti Devi, Aged 65 years, to AIIMS Hospital as well as copy of receipt regarding handing over of body of deceased Smt. Murti Devi to her relatives after postmortem, are attached with the report.

Considering the recent death of grandmother of applicant/accused, he is granted interim bail till 09/06/2026, subject to furnishing bail bond in the sum of Rs.30,000/- with one surety of like amount. The applicant/ accused shall maintain good and peaceful behaviour during the interim bail period.
