1. Ld. Counsel for plaintiff has submitted that an amount of Rs.5 lacs out of subject matter of the cheque in the present case is being held by defendant no.7. It is further submitted that plaintiff and defendants no.2 to 5 are willing to settle the matter if amount held by defendant no.7 is released to the plaintiff.

2. The present suit has been filed by plaintiff alleging that defendant no.1 was an employee of the defendant no.2 company and has stolen certain cheques from the premises of the plaintiff. Since the main allegation in the present suit is against defendant no.1, let the parties address arguments on the aspect as to how plaintiff and defendants no.2 to 5 can settle the matter without even plaintiff proving the same or defendant no.1 agreeing to the settlement.

3. Application under Order I Rule 10 CPC filed by defendants no.2 to 5 is also pending.
