This is an application filed U/s. 483 BNSS on behalf of applicant/accused Vishnu Giri @ Buddhi Ram for grant of bail.

Reply of IO as well as case file are perused.
Arguments heard on bail from both sides.

1. Applicant/accused Vishnu Giri @ Buddhi Ram has sought bail on ground of long custody period of one and half year i.e. since 05/11/2024. Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused argued that the applicant/accused has been falsely implicated in this case and no recovery was effected from his possession. It is argued that the charge has already been framed against the applicant/accused for offence U/s. 61(2)/49 BNS r/w Section 123/306 BNS and the case is at the stage of trial which shall take time to complete. It is argued that applicant/ accused may not be further detained in custody as a punishment during trial.

2. Ld. Addl. PP, on the other hand, strongly opposed the bail with submission that considering the gravity of offence as well as prior criminal antecedents in similar cases, applicant /

accused Vishnu Giri cannot be trusted with grant of bail as he repeatedly tends to misuse the liberty granted through bail. Ld. Addl. PP submitted that the applicant/accused is habituated to committing offence and it is not safe to release him on bail and his bail may be considered after completion of statement of complainant as well as other prosecution witnesses.

3. Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused submitted that the mental health of applicant/accused is also adversely affected because of long custody period, whereas, completion of trial will take time to complete.

4. Considering the long period already spent by applicant/accused in judicial custody in this case and the fact that the case has reached the stage of trial, which shall take time to complete, the bail application is allowed. Applicant/accused Vishnu Giri @ Buddhi Ram is admitted to bail subject to furnishing bail bond in the sum of Rs.30,000/- with one surety of like amount, subject to condition that he shall not attempt to contact, influence, harm or threaten the complainant/victim and the prosecution witnesses, in any manner.

5. However, considering the tendency of applicant/accused to relapse into criminal ways on being granted bail in prior cases, it is deemed necessary to keep check on his activities. Therefore, applicant / accused Vishnu Giri @ Buddhi Ram is

directed to appear and mark his attendance in PS Lajpat Nagar once every 14 days till further orders. If he fails to mark his attendance in the police station once every 14 days till further orders or is found involved in any further criminal case, his bail will be reconsidered and may be cancelled, on the report of concerned SHO. SHO PS Lajpat Nagar shall immediately report to Court if applicant/accused Vishnu Giri @ Buddhi Ram fails to mark his attendance once every 14 days till further orders or is found involved in any further criminal case.

The applicant/accused shall also provide his mobile numbers to SHO PS Lajpat Nagar and will keep it operational at all times.

The application is disposed of accordingly.
