ORDER BELOW EXH.01

This is a complaint u/s. 138 of The Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881. Today the complainant and his advocate are present. The complainant stated that he filed unconditional withdrawal pursis vide **Exh.22** and do not want to proceed with the case. The complainant further stated that the compromise took place between the accused and them and the matter is settled in terms of unconditional withdrawal pursis at **Exh.22**. Hence, he do not want to proceed with the case. Hence, case be disposed of.

2. The contents of pursis were read to the complainant. The complainant admitted the contents of the pursis.

3. Considering the statement of the complainant and his admission regarding the contents of the pursis, it appears that he do not want to proceed with the case. Hence, permission needs to be given to the complainant to withdraw the case. I proceed to pass following order :

ORDER

- 1] The complaint is disposed of as withdrawn vide unconditional withdrawal pursis at **Exh.22**.
- 2] The accused namely **Pansambal Sanjivaji Sambhaji, Proprietor of Sanjivani Laboratory** is acquitted for the offence punishable u/s. 138 of The Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881.
- 3] The bail bond of the accused is cancelled.
- 4] The Court fees be refunded as per rule.
