Order on Interim Bail Application

1. This is an application seeking grant of interim bail moved on behalf of applicant/accused.
2. Reply filed. Taken on record. Copy supplied.
3. It is stated by Ld. Defence counsel that wife of accused/applicant is seriously ill and is required to undergo surgery of gall bladder and therefore, accused/applicant be granted interim bail for a period of one month.
4. The application has been opposed by Subs. Ld. Addl. PP for State assisted by IO arguing that allegations against the accused/applicant are highly serious.
5. Submissions heard. Record perused.
6. It is observed that vide order dated 01.04.2023 of this Court, accused/applicant was admitted to interim bail for a period of 15 days and subsequent to furnishing his Bail Bond, he was released on 12.04.2023. He surrendered before concerned Jail Superintendent on 26.04.2023. It is admitted by Ld. Defence counsel that no surgery of wife of accused/applicant was conducted

during period of interim bail of accused/applicant. No medical document of wife of accused/applicant for the period between 12.04.2023 to 26.04.2023 has been placed on record.

7. Taking note of aforesaid situation and the conduct of accused/applicant, no exceptional circumstances to admit the accused/applicant on interim bail is made out. Accordingly, application is **dismissed**.

8. Application is disposed of accordingly.
