Munni v. Lokender Singh

Present: Ms. Nargis, Ld. counsel for the claimant.

No report regarding status of DAR and chargesheet received from concerned IO/SHO. **Let fresh notice in terms of previous order be issued to concerned IO/SHO through SSP concerned through DCP South-East on filing of PF by claimant for NDOH.**

Nodal Officer of Insurance Company of the concerned jurisdiction also be impleaded as a party.

In the meantime, claimant also be directed to file certified copy of DAR and necessary steps be taken for transfer of the DAR to the same jurisdiction where he/she intends to pursue the claim petition.

Since the accident has taken place at Village Khad Gujar within the jurisdiction of PS Gajrola, U.P. i.e. outside the territorial jurisdiction of this Tribunal, in order to ensure that no simultaneous claim proceedings are being pursued by the same claimant before the other Tribunal, let a copy of this order be sent to concerned Learned MACT court as an intimation of pendency of a claim petition by the claimant before this court.

Also notice be issued to all the respondents on filing of PF&RC, authorized courier, speed post for NDOH. Dasti Notice be also given.

Be put up on 27.03.2024 for awaiting status report from SHO/IO concerned and compliance by petitioner/claimant.

Directions for claimant (s) to open bank accounts:

Claimant (s) are directed to open an MACT saving bank account in a nationalized bank near their place of residence. The concerned bank is directed to not issue any cheque book and debit card to the claimant (s) and if the same have already been issued, the bank is directed to cancel the same and make an endorsement to that effect that on the passbook of the claimant. Claimant (s) are directed to place on record two photographs and their attested specimen signatures from the bank, a copy of the bank pass book with such endorsement from bank, with their Aadhar Card (s) and PAN Card (s) on the next date of hearing. The claimant (s) shall also furnish complete postal address of the bank with their IFS Code and MICR number before the court on the next date of hearing. A copy of this order be given dasti to the claimant (s) for being shown to the bank for compliance.

Further, in view of Rule 32(2) of amended rule of 150A of MV (5th amendment) Rules effective from 01.04.2022 r/w Annexure XIII, **Procedure For Investigation of Motor Vehicle Accidents**, claimants are directed to place on record the following documents, if not already filed:

- (a) Aadhaar Card and PAN Card;
- (b) Details of the Aadhaar Linked Bank Account(s) of the Claimant(s) near the place of their residence along with the proper endorsement; and
- (c) Two sets of photographs and specimen signatures of the claimant(s).
