The case record is taken up for appearance and reconciliation.
Both the petitioners are present before this court.
Both the parties are called upon by this court for reconciliation but they are not at all ready to reunite. Hence, reconciliation fails.
The case record is taken up for hearing.
Parties filed their respective AIC with documents.
Perused the application and affidavit. The petitioners Antara Sil and Rahul Paul entered into a marital tie as per the provisions of Special Marriage Act, on 20.05.2019 and the Marriage Registration Certificate was proved as Exbt.1 .
After marriage, the parties started to reside as husband and wife.
During the continuation of the marriage difference of opinions cropped up between the parties which they failed to solve and started to reside separately on and from 11.04.2022. Parties have applied before this Court by filing this petition u/s.28 of Special Marriage Act. On 09.04.2024 for getting decree of divorce on mutual consent. The solemnization of marriage and residence of the petitioner No.1 is within the limits of Manicktala PS for which, this Court has jurisdiction to try the dispute.
They have supported their versions in their affidavit of examination-in-chief. It appears that parties voluntarily agreed to dissolve their marriage tie by mutual consent. As there is no scope to reunite the parties it will be prudent to allow this petition of divorce by mutual consent.
Hence it is,

O R D E R E D

That instant Mat Suit vide No. Mat Suit No. 167 of 2024 be and the same is allowed on consent u/s.28 of the Special Marriage Act.

The marital tie between Antara Sil and Rahul Paul be and the same is dissolved from this day i.e from 30th day of November, 2024.
