None appeared on behalf of violator.

The cognizance of the offence was already taken by the Virtual Court and fine was proposed for summary disposal of case as per section 208 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988. The violator has exercised option to contest the challan on web portal of virtual traffic courts and the challan is transferred to this court for further adjudication as per law.

Perusal of record reveals that this is one of the oldest matter in this Court. There have been more than 10 hearings of this matter and the presence of the violator could not be secured despite best efforts. He/she was summoned multiple times which were returned unexecuted.

A report regarding the new/fresh address and contact number of the violator was also called from the TI concerned. However, no such report has been received till date.

The Naib Court posted in this court also tried to contact the owner of the vehicle several times but his number was switched off/not reachable.

Keeping in view the above, this Court is of the opinion that continuing the proceedings of this case would not be in the interest of justice since there is no record available of the violator.

This Court deems it fit to exercise its powers u/s 258 Cr.P.C. to stop proceedings in the present matter.

Accordingly, the violator stands discharged and the present challan stands disposed off.
