ORDER BELOW EXH:1

Initially, the applicant filed this claim petition U/s-166 of the M.V. Act, 1988, claiming compensation of Rs.2,00,000/- for the injuries caused to the claimant in vehicular accident. Subsequently, pending the hearing and final disposal of the claim petition, the matter was referred to Lok Adalat and a compromise was arrived at between the parties, vide Purshish **Ex-15**. Both, the applicant and opponent-Insurance Company agreed for **Rs.2,80,000/-** as full and final settlement to be paid to the claimant. Therefore, by this compromise pursis, party seeks disposal of this MACP in Lok Adalat. Accordingly, this compromise is recorded and approved and MACP is disposed of in terms of this compromise pursis. Moreover, in the present claim petition, the Court Fee Refund Certificate, if any, be issued in the name of claimant.

The Insurance Company has to deposit the amount of awarded compensation in the account of State Bank of India at District Court Branch, having the A/c. No. 40746217906, IFSC Code No. SBIN0018839, Branch Code: 18839. After depositing

the awarded amount to the account of District Court, the Ins. Co. shall inform the Tribunal by way of registered E-mail.

The amount of compromise agreed between the parties be entirely paid to the claimant by RTGS/NEFT in his/her Bank Account.

Decree be drawn accordingly.
