File taken up today on an application U/s. 439 Cr. P. C for grant of bail moved on behalf of applicant/accused **Sonu Kumar**.

Present: Dr. Raj Rani, Ld. Addl. PP for the State.
Sh. Robin Kamra, Ld. Chief Legal Aid Defence Counsel for applicant/accused.

Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused submitted that applicant/accused is in JC since 22.06.2020 and he has been falsely implicated in the present case. It is further submitted that nothing has been recovered from the applicant/accused as alleged by the prosecution and the alleged recovery is false and planted one. It is further submitted that applicant/accused is no more required by the prosecution for any law full purpose and his further incarceration shall not bring any fruit on the other hand that will deprive the applicant/accused from his personal liberty. It is prayed that the above said application may kindly be allowed.

On the other hand, Ld. Additional PP for State strongly opposed the bail application and submitted that allegations against the applicant/accused are serious in nature. It is further submitted that applicant/accused actively involved in the commission of alleged offence and weapon of offence i.e. cemented brick, mobile phone and purse of deceased were recovered at the instance of applicant/accused Sonu. It is further submitted that if bail is granted to applicant/accused there are chances he may threaten the witnesses. It is prayed that the above said application may kindly be dismissed.

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This court has given thoughtful consideration to the submissions made by Ld. counsel for applicant/accused and Ld. Additional PP for State and has also perused the record placed before the same.

Perusal of the record shows that vide order dated 04.04.2022, charge for the offences punishable U/s. 302 IPC has been framed against applicant/accused. There are specific allegations against applicant/accused that applicant/accused had abducted Ankit and committed the murder of Ankit by causing multiple injuries on his vital part and other parts of the body with blunt object. Further, present case is at the stage of evidence and also it has come in the testimony of material witnesses that applicant/accused had taken the deceased from his house and had murdered Ankit.

Keeping in view above discussion as well as seriousness of allegations leveled against applicant/accused and seriousness and gravity of offences alleged against him, the **present bail application of applicant/accused Sonu is hereby dismissed.**

Nothing stated herein shall tantamount to any expression of opinion the merits of the case. **Copy of order be given dasti to the applicant/accused.** The present bail application be tagged with the main case file.
