Accused voluntarily pleads guilty. I accept the plea of accused being voluntarily made. Heard the accused on the point of sentence. He submitted that, he is poor person and his family depends on him. It appears that, accused is poor person and is only earning member of the family. Looking to the nature of the offence accused is not entitled for the benefit of Probation of Offenders Act. However, looking to the facts and circumstances of the case, I find there are special and adequate reasons for taking liberal view. After considering all the facts and circumstances of the case, I pass following order-

ORDER

1) Accused is convicted under Section 252 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and is sentenced to suffer S.I. for 10 days and to pay fine of Rs. 1000 + 500 = 1500/-.
I/d to undergo S.I for 10 days for the offence punishable under Section 159 of Railways Act, 1989.

2) Bail bonds of the accused, if any, stands forfeited.

3) Seized vehicle be released in favour of owner on indemnity bond of Rs. 1500/- till appeal period is over. After appeal period the said indemnity bond would stand cancelled and owner can retain the same.
