ORDER

1. Present petition/bail application has been filed by the petitioners namely Sukhjit Singh and Rajpreet Kaur, for grant of anticipatory bail in case F.I.R No. 0058 dated 19.03.2021 under Sections 451, 354, 427, 506, 149 of IPC, registered at Police Station, Fatehgarh Sahib.

2. Learned counsel for petitioners submitted that even as per the allegations in the FIR, complainant was inducted as tenant and now she has levelled false allegations against the petitioner and his wife. He further submitted that petitioners have joined the investigation.

3. On the other hand, learned PP for the State on instructions from ASI Avtar Singh submitted that petitioners have joined the investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation. His statement has been recorded to this effect separately.

4. Keeping in view above, without commenting on the merits of the case, interim order dated 02.04.2021 is made absolute. Anticipatory bail application is disposed of accordingly. File be consigned to Record Room.
