Nishan Singh Vs. State of Punjab

ORDER:

The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Section 480 of BNSS, 2023 (**corresponding provision 437 under old Cr.P.C., 1973**) for grant of regular bail to the **applicant/accused namely Karan Singh**, in case FIR No.27 dated 09.03.2025, under Sections 118(1), 115(2), 191(3), 190 of BNS, 2023 was registered at P.S. Khalra, Tehsil Patti, District Tarn Taran.

2. Heard upon the bail application under Section 480 of BNSS for grant of regular bail. It has been averred in the application that the applicant/accused is in judicial custody since 22.01.2026. The applicant/accused is innocent and has been falsely implicated in the present case. It is submitted that the no any alleged attribution was attributed to the applicant/accused. The applicant/accused was not present at the time of alleged occur-

rence. It is further submitted that unexplained delay of about 01 day of lodging the alleged FIR. The applicant/accused is no more required for any investigation. It is also further submitted that no useful purpose would be served by keeping the applicant/accused into judicial custody. Hence, the present bail application.

3. Arguments so advance by Ld. APP for the State and Ld. Counsel for the accused have been heard and record on judicial file has been perused with their able assistance.

4. As per the contents of the FIR, the present occurrence took place on 08.03.2025 at about 08:30 PM and at the said time the complainant riding on his motorcycle bearing registration No.PB115496 went to purchase household goods from the shop of Kabal Singh and when he reached near UK Milk Dairy, at that time accused Nishan Singh and accused Gullu armed with dattar, accused Amritpal Singh armed with dattar riding on motorcycle Marka CD Delux stopped the motorcycle of the complainant, accused Amritpal Singh raised lalkara and uttered words that caught hold of complainant Jaskarndeeep Singh in order to teach him lesson for quarreling with us. On hearing the lalkara accused Gullu armed with dattar attacked on the head of the complainant and then accused Amritpal Singh gave a dattar blow on the right abdomen of complainant as well as on the right leg. On hue and cry being raised by the complainant, the accused ran away from the spot and thereafter, the accused was referred at Civil Hospital, Tarn Taran. As per the contents of the FIR there is no specific attribution against the applicant/accused Nishan Singh.

The fact cannot be denied that applicant/accused Nishan Singh gathered with his co-accused at the spot with the common intention of causing injuries on the person of the complainant. At this stage, this Court is of the view that it appear that injuries on the person of the complainant were pre-meditated. The contention of the Ld. Counsel for the accused that there is delay of 1 day in lodging of the FIR can be appreciated at the time of trial and not at this stage. Considering the nature and seriousness of the offence, this Court deems fit to dismissed the present application as the accused got arrested in the present case on 22.01.2026 and this Court is of the opinion that he is required for further custodial interrogation. This Court is satisfied that at this stage of the case the applicant/accused does not deserve the concession of bail. Moreover, the accused may tamper with the evidence, if released on bail. As such, in considered view of this Court, the accused is not entitled to the benefit of the bail.

5. In view of the reasons mentioned above, this Court is of the considered and confirmed view that the accused/applicant **Nishan Singh** is not entitled to benefit of the bail in the instant case. As such, the instant application stands **dismissed**. Papers be tagged with the main file.
