1. Appellant Govind Singh was convicted for offence U/s. 138 N. I. Act by Ld. JMFC (NI Act)-01, South-East District, Saket Courts, vide judgment dated 26/05/2025. Vide order on sentence dated 20/09/2025, the appellant was sentenced to pay fine of Rs.9,90,000/- with simple interest thereon @ 6% per annum from the date of filing of complaint till the date of judgment/conviction, to be paid as compensation to the complainant within 60 days. In default of payment of fine, the appellant/convict was ordered to undergo sentence of Simple Imprisonment of 02 months.

2. **The appeal is accompanied by application for condonation of delay and application U/s. 430 (1) of BNSS, 2023, seeking suspension of sentence and grant of bail.**

3. Subject to prior deposit of part compensation amount of Rs.1,50,000/- as security, the operation of impugned judgment dated 26/05/2025 and sentence dated 20/09/2025 shall be suspended till further orders/disposal of appeal, whichever is earlier.

4. The order of sentence dated 20/09/2025 shall remain suspended till pendency of present appeal subject to deposit Rs.1,50,000/- of the total fine amount of Rs.9,90,000/- (in the name of respondent/complainant) in the form of FDR/demand draft within 60 days from today before Ld. Trial Court. The respondent shall be at liberty to approach Ld. Trial Court for release of same in his favour **subject to furnishing of indemnity bond of same amount** and as per law subject to the condition that in case the appellant succeeds in appeal, the amount alongwith the interest as determined by the Court shall be returnable. A report be called from Ld. Trial Court regarding deposit/non-deposit of fine amount by next date of hearing.

5. The appellant is admitted to bail on furnishing PB/SB in the sum of Rs.25,000/- to the satisfaction of Ld. Trial Court, subject to prior furnishing of part compensation amount ordered today.

6. **Issue notice of appeal as well as application for condonation of delay to R-1/complainant, on PF/speed post, for next date of hearing. Steps be taken within 07 days.**

Put up for appearance of respondent/complainant and further proceedings on 12/01/2026.

Copy of this order be sent to Ld. Trial Court and be given dasti to Ld. Counsel for appellant, for compliance.

TCR be requisitioned four days prior to the next date of hearing.
