File taken up today for considering the bail application moved on behalf of accused Abdullah.

Record reveals that both the said accused were PO and after their apprehension in the matter, the supplementary charge sheet was filed by the IO and the same was received after committal on 09.03.2017.

Heard both sides on the application moved on behalf of accused for grant of bail u/s 439 Cr.PC.

Accused is stated to be in JC since 10.12.2016 when he was arrested as PO u/s 41.1 Cr.PC. The counsel for the accused submits that the allegation against the present accused are only pertaining to section 212 IPC and section 14 of the Foreigners Act. However it is pointed out by Ld. Addl. PP that accused was declared PO and further they absconded from the police custody while they were brought to Delhi by the police.

Considering the aforementioned conduct of the accused in absconding from the police custody, there is every chance of their again escaping from the hands of justice, if enlarged on bail. Hence, no ground is made out for grant of bail.

The application is accordingly rejected.
