Heard. As per the allegations, 24 bottles of illicit liquor make Mala Malta (Haryana) were recovered from the spot on the basis of secret information. Allegedly, applicant was not arrested from the spot. Applicant has joined the investigation and it is a matter of evidence whether the recovered bottles belongs to applicant/ accused or not. Therefore at this stage, keeping in view of the entire circumstances of the case, this Court is of the considered view that applicant is entitled for concession of bail. Accordingly, the interim order dated 29.11.2018 passed by this court is made absolute, subject to the conditions as enshrined in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. File be consigned to the record room.
