Ramesh Chand Gupta son of late Sh. Shri Ram Gupta

Heard on the application filed by applicants claiming themselves legal heir of petitioner Ramesh Chand Gupta. It is averred in the application that Ramesh Chand died on 12.11.2020 leaving behind Bhagwati Devi (widow), Mahesh Chand Gupta, Rajesh Gupta and Yogesh Kumar (sons) as well as Rajani Gupta (married daughter). There is no other legal heirs of the deceased except the above said persons.

In order to prove the contents of the application, applicants appeared and their joint statement was recorded. They placed on record death certificate of Ramesh Chand Gupta.

A minute reading of the statements of applicants coupled with death certificate reveals that petitioner Ramesh Chand Gupta was petitioner in present case. He passed away from this World on 12.11.2020 leaving behind the applicants as legal heirs.

In the light of above discussion, the application moved by the legal heirs of Ramesh Chand Gupta stands allowed. Applicants be brought on the record as legal heirs of deceased Ramesh Chand Gupta.

Application for impleading the applicants as legal heirs of
Shri Raja Ram, respondent no.7

Heard on the application filed by applicants claiming themselves legal heir of Raja Ram , respondent no.7 (since deceased). It is averred in the application that respondent no.7 Raja Ram has expired on 13.12.2020 leaving behind applicants namely Ishwar Chand, Trilok Chand, Babita Gupta and Prashant Gupta as his legal heirs. There is no other legal heirs of the deceased except the above said persons. It is further averred that a registered WILL dated 26.8.2015 was executed by Raja Ram (since deceased) in favour of his three sons and daughter in law who inherited the property in question.
