Satender Kumar Antil, the accused is enlarged on bail on execution of the bail bond in sum of Rs. 20,000/- with one surety of like nature and following conditions are imposed upon the accused.

1. He shall not threaten or influence the witnesses.
2. He shall not tamper with evidence.
3. He shall appear before the Court on each and every date of hearing.
4. He shall not leave the country without prior permission of the court.
5. He shall not try to contact the complainant and his family members.

Bond furnished by accused. Proposed surety is also present. Heard. Perused. Considered. Accepted.

It is submitted that documents supplied are complete and are in order.

The offence punishable under section 376 IPC is exclusively triable by the Hon'ble Court of Sessions. Therefore, the present case is committed to the Hon'ble Court of Sessions for trial. It be notified to Ld. Public Prosecutor.

The Ahlmad is directed to complete the file in all respects and place it before the Ld. Principal District & Sessions Judge, HQs on **23.03.2026** for the necessary order.
