ORDER BELOW EXHIBIT D-21

(Delivered on this the 9th day of the month of June, of the year, 2026)

By this order I shall dispose of application filed by the plaintiff at Exhibit D-21 for taking rejoinder on record.

2. The plaintiff has stated that plaintiff is desirous to produce his affidavit in rejoinder in response to the reply filed to the application of temporary injunction by the defendants and therefore prayed that said rejoinder be taken on record. Hence prayed that application be granted.

3. In reply to the said application at Exhibit 27, the defendant No. 12 stated that arguments on application for temporary injunction are already heard in the matter and that there is no provision to file rejoinder after the arguments are heard. It is also stated that no leave sought to place on record such affidavit in rejoinder, hence prayed that the same may not be taken on record.

4. Heard learned Adv. Ms. A. Furtado for the Plaintiff, Ld. Adv. Shri. N. Araujo for the defendant No. 3, 14 and 15 and Ld. Adv. Shri. J. Martins for defendant No. 12. Perused the records.

5. Ld. Adv. Shri. J. Martins for the defendant No. 12, strongly objected for taking rejoinder on record, submitting that there is no justification given as to why same can be filed after hearing arguments.

6. The affidavit in rejoinder said to be relied upon is in response to the reply filed to the application for temporary injunction. The party now wishes to file reply in response to the reply filed for application for temporary injunction.

7. The said rejoinder if any will certainly be pertaining to the present suit and it is the statement of the plaintiff in support of his pleadings, hence the permission can be granted to produce the same.

8. As far as objections of the defendants are concerned the same can be taken care of by giving a opportunity to the defendants to file reply to the same. Allowing the present application to take on record the rejoinder of the plaintiff will assist the Court in properly adjudication of the matter.

9. Hence in the interest of justice, I pass the following:-

ORDER

The application at Exhibit D-21 stands granted.

- a. The rejoinder of the plaintiff to be taken on record.
- b. An opportunity is granted to the defendants to file
reply to the said rejoinder.
