

JOGINDER SINGH & ORS. VS STATE OF PUNJAB etc.

Record perused. Heard on the bail application.

It has been contended by Id. Counsel for the accused-applicants that no case is made out against the accused-applicant and they have been falsely implicated in the above said case. No recovery is to be effected from the accused-applicants and they are not required for further interrogation. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the accused behind bars till the presentation of challan and thus accused-applicants have prayed that they be granted bail. Further, as per report of Ahlmad, the bail applications of Joginder Singh, Balwinder Singh and Laadi have been dismissed on 24.08.2022, 22.08.2022 and 12.11.2021 respectively by the Ld. Appellate courts and no bail application of said accused is pending in Ld. Appellate Court, Court, Patiala and and also no case is found in the said FIR as per Hon'ble High Court website.

Notice of the bail application was issued to the Ld.APP for the State for today who did not file reply to the same but has orally opposed the application. Further HC Surjit Singh, No.1060/Patiala PS Julkan, Patiala has made a statement that no other bail application has been filed by the said accused in relation with the present FIR. He further stated that besides the present case, eight cases against accused Joginder Singh and nine cases against accused Balwinder Singh, as mentioned in the list attached, have been registered.

Perusal of papers shows that the present FIR has been lodged against the accused-applicant U/Ss 379/411 IPC by PS Julkan, Patiala. The accused-applicants are in judicial custody since 25.08.2022. The other pending FIRs against accused-applicants are not of similar nature. The presentation of challan and conclusion of trial shall take long time and no useful purpose will be served by detaining the accused in custody for an indefinite period. Accordingly, accused-applicants are admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- each with a surety of the like amount.
