

Baljinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab

Heard. In this case, accused/applicant was granted interim bail passed on **12.1.2021** and accused/applicant was directed to join investigation. He has complied with the directions. Today, **SI Baljit Kaur** has come present and suffered a statement that the applicant has joined investigation and he is no longer required for further investigation in this case. In the light of above situation, interim order dated **12.1.2021** is made absolute and the application is allowed accordingly with the conditions as under :

1. That applicant shall attend Court on each and every date of hearing;
2. That applicant shall not commit an offence similar to the offence of which applicant is accused, or suspected, of the commission of which applicant is suspected;
3. That applicant shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer or tamper with the evidence; and
4. That applicant shall not leave the country without prior permission of Court.
