**First Bail Application under Section 483 BNSS**

**ORDER**

Present bail application has been filed by accused/applicant Harman Preet Singh seeking regular bail under Section 483 of BNSS. Ravinder Singh who is stated to be father of accused/applicant has also filed his affidavit that this is the first bail application filed on behalf of accused/applicant under section 483 of BNSS. As per the report of the Ahlmad, as per CIS this is first bail of accused/applicant.

2. Upon notice, learned APP for the State put in appearance on behalf of the State and contested the bail application. Police record has also been requisitioned. ASI Bir Singh No. 460/GSP, Police Station Sadar Gurdaspur has appeared alongwith record and also suffered statement to the effect that no other bail application of the accused/applicant is pending in any court in this FIR and total recovery in this FIR is 19.50 Gram Heroin. He also stated that Section 29 of NDPS Act was also added in the FIR.

3. Learned counsel for accused/applicant filed application for addition of Section 29 of NDPS in the head note of the bail application which is considered and allowed. He also filed amended head note of the bail application and submitted that accused/applicant is innocent and has been falsely implicated in the present case. He argued that the alleged joint recovery of 19.50 gram heroin is planted one and in fact nothing was recovered from the possession of accused/applicant. He further submitted that accused/applicant is in judicial custody since 29.05.2025. Therefore, he prayed that accused/applicant be granted concession of bail.

4. On the other hand, learned APP for the State has opposed the bail application on the ground that accused/applicant was found in possession of 19.50 Gram Heroin and thus he prayed for dismissal of the bail application.

5. After hearing both the sides and after going through the record, this court finds that the present FIR has been registered

against present accused/applicant Harmanpreet Singh and other two non applicants namely Angad Ghuman and Harkamal at P.S. Sadar Gurdaspur on 29.05.2025 when they were apprehended by police party of police station Sadar Gurdaspur on the basis of suspicion in a car bearing registration number PB35-P-0988 and thereafter 19.50 grams of heroin was recovered from the dashboard of said car. As per the contents of the FIR, accused/applicant was travelling alongwith non applicant and he was sitting on the back seat of said car and thus allegations against him are that he was in joint and conscious possession of said heroin. The recovery in this case is of 19.50 Gram Heroin which is also intermediate quantity. The fact of the said recovery and join and conscious possession are yet to be proved. Accused/applicant is in custody since 29.05.2025. No other criminal antecedents of accused/applicant have been pointed out. Therefore, no purpose would be served by keeping the accused/applicant behind bars for indefinite period as presentation of challan and conclusion of trial is likely to take sufficient time. As such, present bail application is hereby allowed and accused/applicant Harman Preet Singh is admitted to regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount and subject to the following conditions:-

- i That he shall attend the court regularly;
- ii That he shall not hinder the ongoing investigation/trial;
- iii That he shall not leave the country without prior

permission of the Court;

- iv That he shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him/her from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer or tamper with the evidence;
- v. That he shall not commit an offence similar to the offence of which he is accused or suspected.

However, the observations made herein-above shall have no effect on the merits of the main case. Police record be returned and record of the present bail application be attached with remand papers.
