Today the case is fixed for SR.

Learned APP is present.

The accused **Tahir Miah** is absent but filed a petition pleading guilty through his pleader learned counsel Mr. H. Ch. Das.

Copy of PR furnished to the accused through learned engaged counsel.

Heard both sides on the aforesaid petition.

Substance of accusation **U/S. 194(D) of M.V. Act** is verbally explained to the messenger of the accused person in Bengali to which the messenger pleaded guilty on behalf of the aforesaid accused person as authorized by the accused person in this regard. In view of the provision of sub-Section 2 of Section 253 of Cr.P.C the plea of guilty is accepted and the accused **Tahir Miah** convicted accordingly and the said convict is sentenced to pay a fine of **Rs. 500/-** only.

Taking a lenient view, the convict is sentenced to pay a fine of **Rs. 500/-** in total **U/S. 194(D) of M.V. Act**, i.d to suffer SI for 2(two) days.

Fine money of **Rs. 500/-** is received vide Receipt No **202364 dated 16.03.2023.**

Deposit the fine money to the Govt. treasury **through Nazir of this establishment** by way of Challan keeping copy of T.R. Form No. 2 with record.

This case is disposed of uncontested.
