Fresh petition u/s 166 of Motor Vehicle Act has been received by way of assignment. It be checked & registered.

Present : Sh. Kumar Shivam, counsel for the petitioners.

The instant petition has been filed for compensation under the provisions of Motor Vehicle Act with respect to the fatal accident of the deceased Chanchal Kumar which had occurred on 23.11.2025 within the jurisdiction of PS Masoori, Ghaziabad, U.P.

In compliance to Rule 8 (2b) of Delhi MACT Rules, 2008, affidavit of evidence of Priya i.e. the petitioner no.1 has been filed along with the list of witnesses. In the list of witnesses, opposite to 'eye-witness', it is stated 'after filing of the charge-sheet'. Ld. Counsel for the petitioners undertakes that no witness other than the witness mentioned in the charge-sheet shall be examined.

Subject to the said undertaking, let notice of the claim petition be issued to all the respondents for next date through all modes on taking steps within a week from today.

The petitioners shall get opened their Saving Bank Account in any nationalized bank near the place of their residence, if already not opened with the following directions:

- (i) The concerned Bank Manager(s) of the Bank(s) where the petitioner(s) already has/have bank account or a new bank account is opened, is/are directed as follows:
- (ii) No Cheque Book and ATM/ Debit Card be issued to the petitioner(s) without permission of the Court/MACT Tribunal. However, in case the ATM/Debit Card and/or Cheque Book have already been issued, bank shall cancel the same before the disbursement of the amount.

- (iii) The Bank shall not permit any joint name(s) to be added in the savings bank account or fixed deposit accounts of the petitioner(s). However, money may be released by means of a withdrawal slip.
- (iv) The Bank Manager of petitioners' bank is also directed to make endorsement regarding compliance of aforesaid directions on the passbook.
- (b) After the Bank Manager makes the endorsement regarding compliance of the aforesaid directions on the bank passbook of the petitioner(s), the petitioner(s) shall produce the original passbook having the said endorsements as well as their Aadhaar Card and PAN Card before the Tribunal on the next date of hearing or in any case before hearing the final arguments.
- (c) If the petitioner(s) fail to comply with the said direction, the disbursement of the award amount (if the award is passed) shall be made subject to the following conditions:
- (i) The petitioner(s) shall have to open a MACT compliant Bank account in the UCO Bank, Karkardooma, subject to aforesaid terms and conditions and the petitioner(s) shall also furnish details of the branch of UCO bank near the place of petitioner's residence to which the bank account of the petitioner in the UCO bank, Karkardooma branch may be transferred subject to all hereinabove conditions.

Copy of this order be given dasti to the petitioners, free of cost.
