This petition having been heard on today and court on the same day passed the following orders :-

ORDER

This is an application filed U/s.23(2) of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 seeking interim protection order.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner. Perused the affidavit and other documents filed along with the petition. Petitioner has made out a prima facie allegation as to domestic violence. I am satisfied that the application *prima facie* discloses that there is a likelihood that the respondents may commit acts of domestic violence. The issuance of urgent notice to respondents would not serve the purpose of the petition. Interference of this court is highly necessary for the protection of the petitioners/aggrieved persons from domestic violence. Hence, invoking power u/s.23 of Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act 2005, the following ex-parte ad-interim order is passed:-

- 1. The respondent is hereby restrained from harming or injuring or endangering the health, safety, life or limb of the aggrieved persons/petitioner or from causing any act of physical or verbal or emotional violence against the petitioner u/s.18(a) of Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act 2005.*

Issue notice to the respondent, return of notice to 27.12.25

The other reliefs will be considered after hearing both the parties.

Hence, the petition is allowed in part.

Issue a copy of this order of free of cost of the parties to the application and officer in charge of Police Station concerned and woman protection officer. Issue notice to the respondent along with the copy of this order.
