File taken up today on an application u/s 439 Cr.P.C for grant of interim bail for a period of 30 days moved on behalf of applicant Sandeep @ Bablu.

It is submitted by Id counsel for applicant that applicant has been granted bail as per the guidelines of H.P.C of Hon'ble Delhi High Court and applicant has not misused the same. It is further submitted by Id counsel for applicant that applicant is a patient of Acute Asthmatic with (BA) and he is getting treatment for the same since last more than seven years. It is further argued by Id counsel that presently applicant is taking treatment from Bhagwani Nursing Home, Ballabgrah, Haryana and also using MDI asthalic inhaler. It is further submitted that applicant may be granted interim bail so that he can get proper treatment for said problem.

Per contra, Id Substitute Additional P.P has opposed the bail application and has submitted that applicant is booked for serious offence and non misuse of interim bail given as per guidelines of H.P.C is no ground for granting interim bail to him.

Heard. Perusal of medical documents of the applicant reveals that applicant remained admitted only for 1-2 days and thereafter he was discharged. Presently the condition of applicant is not so serious. Further the applicant is booked for an offence of murder, which is serious in nature. Accordingly the present bail application of the applicant is dismissed and disposed of accordingly.
