This petition having come up before me for final hearing on today for consideration this Tribunal passed the following:

A W A R D

The above application is filed u/s 166 (1)(a) of the Motor Vehicle Act 1988 claiming compensation for the injuries sustained by the petitioner in a motor vehicle accident.

2. The claim is settled out of court for ₹5,00,000/- between the petitioner and the respondent No.3 and a joint statement is filed to that effect. Considering the settlement arrived at between the parties, the joint statement is accepted and the settlement is recorded and the award is

passed for ₹5,00,000/- (Rupees five lakh only) in terms of the settlement. Hence, respondent No.3 is directed to credit the amount in the bank account No. 0789053000000339 of the petitioner with South Indian Bank Ltd., S N Puram branch with IFS Code SIBL0000789 by NEFT or RTGS or any other electronic mode within 30 days from the date of award. Upon deposit being made, the respondent No.3 shall submit to this Motor Accidents Claims Tribunal, a copy of the bank payment advice and a memo in the prescribed format. A copy of the payment advice along with the memo shall be served on the petitioner and his counsel in compliance with the Circular No.1/2025 dated 19/09/2025 of the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala. The respondent No.3 shall provide Form -16 A under the Income Tax Act 1961 to the petitioner. The joint statement will form part of the award.
