ORDER

Application for bail for offence under Section 22/29 NDPS Act has been filed. Through the instant application, it is averred that the applicant filed bail application and in the said bail application only Section 22 NDPS was mentioned and addition of Section 29 of NDPS Act was not in the knowledge of the applicant. When the surety bonds were furnished before the Area Magistrate and release warrants were sent to Central Jail Hoshiarpur then accused was not released due to non mentioning of Section 29 NDPS Act on the release warrants. The non-mentioning of Section 29 NDPS Act was not intentional. There is no connection between applicant and co-accused as nothing is there on the record to establish any kind of link between both the accused. Hence this application.

2. Notice of the application was issued to the State through learned Addl. PP for the State.

3. Heard. Perusal of record shows that initially the FIR in the present

case has been registered under Section 22 of ND&PS Act against the applicant/accused Pardeep Kumar and later on offence under Section 29 ND&PS Act has been added vide DDR No. 13 dated 27.9.2025. Perusal of file further reveals that the offence under Section 29 NDPS Act has not been mentioned in the bail application alongwith the offence under Section 22 NDPS Act. As per record the applicant-accused has already been ordered to be released on regular bail under Sections 22 NDPS Act vide order dated 27.10.2025 passed by this Court. As such in view of the facts and circumstances, the application in hand is allowed and the applicant is also granted regular bail under Section 29 NDPS Act in addition to the offences in which he has already been granted regular bail by this court vide order dated 27.10.2025. The terms and conditions of the bail as mentioned in order dated 27.10.2025 shall applicable to this order as well. Further considering the request of the counsel for the accused/applicant for considering the bonds already furnished, applicant is directed to be released under Section 29 NDPS Act on furnishing fresh personal bonds of the accused/surety against the same property, subject matter of the surety bonds previously furnished in the present matter. This order shall remain part and parcel of the order dated 27.10.2025 vide which the regular bail was granted to the applicant-accused under Sections 22 NDPS Act. Papers be attached with the bail application.
